PITTSBURGH (AP) - Is Mike McCurry Teeling any pangs of regret for leaving his job as White House spokesman? Doesn't look

McCurry jumped in the air, spread his arms wide and shouted "Free at last!" when he was asked Monday how he felt about quitting his job nearly three weeks ago.

And he doesn't appear to miss the boss too much either, describing President Clinton as "an enormously gifted and richly qualified leader for our nation but someone who is exasperatingly stupid in his personal life."

He said Clinton's presidency "will always be marred --- stained by the episode with Monica Lewinsky."

The speech to about 200 people at the University of Pittsburgh was McCurry's first public lecture since he left the White House on Oct. 1.

McCurry admitted he was duped by Clinton's initial public claim that he didn't have an affair with Lewinsky.

"I was aware of the potential for deception, but I just didn't want to believe he had the capacity to deceive," McCurry said.

He spared no criticism for the White House press corps, saying he was "literally stunned" in many press briefings during the Lewinsky scandal when reporters failed to ask a single question about other issues.

The federal lawsuit was filed in 1996 by Stacy Galonsky, a former associate producer of "The Montel Williams Show," and Mahri Feldman, a former executive assistant. The two claimed Williams groped them and made lascivious remarks, and that they were fired when they com-

The lawsuit was joined by four others. The claims of two plaintiffs were thrown out and the rest gradually withdrew.

The last to go was Ms. Feldman. Her lawyer declined to comment Monday,

From the start, Williams called the lawsuit groundless and said he would never settle. The claims "weren't even root-

ed in anything resembling truth," 'So I stood firm and fought back, and one by one these

charges fell away."

Spooky films top box office

LOS ANGELES (AP) - With average, \$8.17 million, one week. Halloween right around the corner, two films with supernatural themes were the top draws at theaters over the weekend. The dark comedy "Happiness" also did well in limited release.

Starring Sandra Bullock and Nicole Kidman as witches, "Practical Magic" made its debut at No. 1 with \$13.1 million on a weekend that saw an 18 percent increase in business from the same time a year ago.

"Bride of Chucky" was second with \$11.8 million, the best debut for any film in the evil doll series. "Beloved" also debuted well, finishing fifth with \$8.17 million and the best per-theater average (\$5,400) of any film in wide release.

Maintaining box-office strength were "Antz," which collected \$11.2 million for third place, and "Rush Hour," which brought in \$8.2 million.

Making an impressive debut in limited release was the black comedy "Happiness," which grossed \$130,303 for a huge perlocation average of \$21,717.

## Court won't remove 'Huck Finn' from reading list

SAN FRANCISCO (AP) — A fed- and Faulkner's "A Rose for Emily" black woman's request to remove ninth-grade English classes. "Huckleberry Finn" and a William Faulkner story from the requiredreading list at her daughter's high

Courts cannot "ban books or other literary works from school curricula on the basis of their content ... even when the works are accused of being racist," the 9th U.S. Circuit Court of Appeals said Monday.

The court allowed the parent, Kathy Monteiro, to sue the Tempe Union High School District for allegedly failing to respond to complaints that white students were harassing blacks with racial slurs and graffiti.

But the judges said the Arizona school could not be required to remove the books as a way to

reduce harassment. Ms. Monteiro had sought to remove Mark Twain's "The Adventures of Huckleberry Finn"

She was unhappy that her daughter, now a senior at McClintock High School, had to read books which repeatedly use the word "nigger,"

The lawsuit said the assignment of the books discriminated against black students, created a racially hostile environment and caused an increase in harassment.

U.S. District Judge Stephen McNamee dismissed the lawsuit in January 1997, saying he was aware that the language in the books was offensive and hurtful but did not find their assignment discriminatory.

The appeals court said a student's constitutional rights are violated when a book that has educational value, as determined by the school district, is removed from a required-reading list by threat of a lawsuit.
